Services Requested Summary

MACH is seeking a Health Educator from June 2021 through September 2022 to provide the services outlined in the Funding Agreement with Public Health Agency of Canada's Immunization Partnership Fund. The project seeks to improve confidence in, uptake of, and access to vaccines, including COVID-19 vaccines, among vulnerable populations across Canada. It also

aims to improve Community Health Centre (CHC) and health system capacity to deliver equity-informed, evidence-based vaccination promotion that is relevant to and effective for use with vulnerable and marginalized populations.

CVP Manitoba is part of a five project collaborative between the Canadian Association of Community Health Centres (CACHC) and four other province-specific CVP projects being led by the provincial associations for CHCs in British Columbia, Manitoba, Ontario, and Nova Scotia. As the Health Educator for the Community Vaccination Promotion Manitoba Project (CVP Manitoba), you will be responsible for supporting the successful roll out of this important initiative that is seeking to improve confidence in, uptake of, and access to COVID-19 vaccines, as well as to vaccines in general, among vulnerable populations in Manitoba and to improve CHC and health system capacity to deliver equity informed, evidence-based vaccination promotion that is relevant to and effective for use with vulnerable and marginalized populations. Responsibilities include:

- Develop community education and training workshops in collaboration with other project staff members and support other CVP Manitoba staff to deliver community education and service provider training, via virtual platforms and in person sessions
- Support Project Advisory Committee
- Support development of micro-website for dissemination of project materials
- Work with member agencies to identify community and service provider needs

Bidder Qualifications

- Degree in social work, health promotion, or equivalent with a minimum of 3 years' related experience.

- Understanding of and demonstrated success implementing community development, outreach and engagement and adult education initiatives.
- Demonstrated skills in project management, time management, interpersonal communication, and problem solving.
- Strong oral and written communication skills.
- Proficient in web-based tools and MS Office software, including spreadsheet and presentation applications, and comfortable with web and social media technologies to foster engagement.
- Able to work independently and to collaborate well with team members with excellent networking, leadership, relationship building, interpersonal and listening skills to work effectively with a broad range of stakeholders and to facilitate the development of partnerships.
- Demonstrated commitment to principles of equity, inclusivity, respect and cultural competence is required.
- Bilingualism (French/English) is an asset.
