## 2STLGBQ+ PNP Peer Outreach Worker, Winnipeg

### 7 hours per week

Peer N Peer (PNP) is a harm reduction program for 2STLGBQ+ who use drugs with sex. PNP is about meeting folks where they're at on their substance use and sexual health journey. The Peer Outreach Worker brings their lived experiences to support folks accessing sexual health and substance use supplies in a way that meets the needs of community.

#### WHAT YOU BRING

- Lived experience as a 2STLGBQ+ person who uses/has used substances.
- Experience providing community support/services to peers.

#### WHAT YOU'LL DO

- Support the distribution of education and harm reduction supplies to 2STLGBQ+ community members including packing and delivery.
- Promote the project.
- Assist in online outreach services including MyBuzz.ca and dating apps/sites.
- Take part in community advisory meetings.
- Work may include entering sexualized spaces like bars, dating apps/sites or bathhouses.
- May encounter intoxicated, aggressive and/or agitated clients/visitors.
- Required to work a variety of shifts including evenings and weekends.

**WAGE:** \$25.00 per hour

**TERM:** Until March 31, 2023
