- Develop and Present strategic plan
- Develop and Present accompanying operational plan
- Provide a schedule of compensation
- Complete the SERC strategic and operational plan by May 30, 2026.

# **Proposal Requirements**

Proposals must include the following:

- A detailed overview of the company, indicating the scope of the practice and range of activities provided by your company
- Detailed information on the qualifications and experience of company staff or consultants to be assigned to the project
- Description of experience in strategic planning for nonprofits, including community health agencies
- Description of the understanding of the work to be done, including the approach, proposed work plan demonstrating the ability to complete the work within the required timelines. The project must be completed by May 30, 2026
- Provide a detailed fee proposal including cost breakdown for consultations, surveys, focus groups, meetings, documents, and tools. Proposals under \$15,000 may be considered.



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• Provide three client references, including contact information and examples of work, for website development projects completed by the company

Proposals must include all information above to be considered for review.
